  - -Circulation: Omit local reference for summer patrons; Solidify loaning periods
  - -Community Event Room: Re-write religious groups inclusion/exclusion; Change language to "Hold Harmless Agreement" rather than "reservation application"; Change "any item left for more than 24 hours" to "seven (7) days" will be disposed of.
