2022 A YEAR OF TRANSITION.

We returned to pre-pandemic operation hours with new hires, expanded programs, and increased community outreach. We added weekly take home crafts with puzzles and coloring pages. We had tech help and technology classes offered by staff member, Logan. For our Summer Reading Program, 11 elementary aged children read 335 books. We had Warrensburg born and raised, Ringling Clown, Ted Lawrence and his Trunkside Tales, for a program in the Summer. With an ALA Libraries Transforming Communities Grant, we focused on developing our YA space. For outreach, we had a craft table at 4 of 5 Riverside Farmers' Market Festivals in Warrensburg. In October, we hosted 13 Warrensburg Elementary classes for tours of the library. During Christmas in Warrensburgh, the library hosted a Pinecone Owl Ornament craft. The library received a generous donation from Jeffrey M. Levine towards our Community Room, which was named in his honor in 2021. From November 14 to December 14, the library collected nonperishable food items in place of money for fines, which was donated to the First Presbyterian Food Pantry in Warrensburg."
